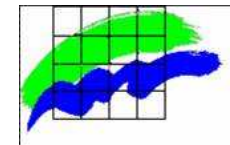
≡ Activities

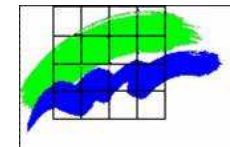

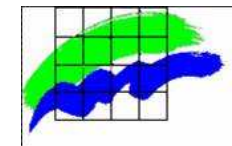

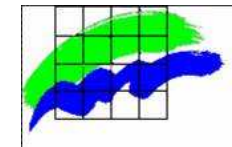

Milestone 5 - July - December 2006

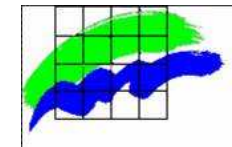
≡ Activities

- Final report on practices in watercourse related spatial planning



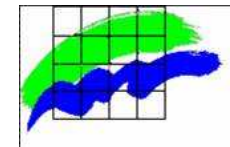
Milestone 6 - January - June 2007

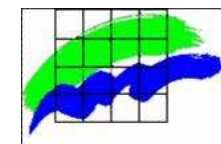
